



### Senior Review

All patients are reviewed by their Most Responsible Provider (MRP) (senior review) before mid-day. The review should be informed by a multi-professional assessment and consider social and environmental factors. to facilitate discharge.



### All patients

and/or their delegates/essential care partners will be involved in setting an **Expected Discharge Date** based on the clinical and functional **criteria for discharge**. This is set assuming ideal recovery and no avoidable delays.



### Flow

of patients from the ED to an available inpatient unit bed will occur as soon as a bed is ready for admission, preferably mid-day on a 24/7 basis.



### Early Discharge

>33% of patients will be discharged from inpatient wards by mid-day.



### Review

For those patients at risk of an extended length of stay (>6 days), a multi-disciplinary team case conference (review) that includes patients and families is conducted with a "home first" mindset.



### Frailty

is assessed, reviewed by the MRP and considered when establishing Criteria-led Discharge, Expected Date of Discharge, care plans, goals of care, and in those patients at risk for extended lengths of stay.
