



Quality Summit criteria for oral and poster presentations

We are looking to highlight the incredible people, inspiring stories and projects demonstrating collaboration, innovation, quality improvement and safety at the 2023 Quality Summits. If you have an initiative that fits the criteria below, please submit it via the QI Hub.

To be considered for an oral or poster presentation, your initiative should:

- Clearly articulate the Quality Improvement or Clinical/Service Quality Project (as defined on the [QI Hub](#)).

There will be two formats of presentations:

- **Oral presentations** are for initiatives that are mature in their development. They must clearly show the use of quality improvement measurement with emerging/established impact that tested changes are improving outcomes for patients, families and/or providers.
- **Poster presentations** are for initiatives earlier in their development. They will focus on better understanding the problem / issues and opportunities, using evidence, to improve quality of clinical and/or services for patients, families and/or providers.

Note: all Quality Summit presentations, both oral and poster, must submit a storyboard using the NS Health [storyboard template](#) via the [QI Hub](#).

Selections will be based on representation of:

- site, service, program, issue/focus.
- system leaders, physicians, patient family advisors and front-line staff/providers.
