



## Documenting Shingrix Administration in Accuro

To ensure Shingrix immunizations are shared electronically with Public Health and accessible to your patients in VaxRecordNS/YourHealthNS, please follow the instructions below. Accuro users **MUST map the Shingrix vaccine in the application** to the Public Health approved Immunization Agent.

### Map the Shingrix Vaccine to Immunization Agent:

1. Click Accuro **Start Menu**



2. Type **Manage Vaccines** in the search box
3. Select **Vaccine** > Shingles – Herpes Zoster
4. Select **Immunization Abbreviation** – Shingles – Herpes Zoster
5. Select **Immunization Agent** – ZOS

6. Enter **Lot #**
7. Enter **Expiry Date**
8. Complete other fields > **OK**

### When Recording Administered Shingrix Vaccines:

1. **Administered Date** should not be dated in the future
2. **Immunization Agent** has a value
3. **Administered by** field should not have commas or other punctuations
